# Facts & Figures: 2003-2004

*These figures are based on fiscal year: July, 2003 to June, 2004.*

**Founded:** 1930; Seeley G. Mudd Building completed in 1975

**Total operating budget 2003/04:** 3.6 million (This includes Archives)

**Staff:** 40.5 FTE including 15.8 professional librarians (This includes Archives)

**Staffing:** The Library is open 86 hours per week

**Collection:** 288,136 volumes including the Trent Collection in the History of Medicine; approximately 747 current print subscriptions and 2,600 electronic journal titles

**Total items added to collection:** 4,024

**Total number of primary clients:** 13,023

**Lending of items (external circulation):** 20,659

**Gate count:** 140,461

**Net assignable square feet:** 47,526

**Information services:** 15,604 questions were answered at the Library Service Desk and other service points

**Interlibrary loan:** 2,768 items were borrowed; 16,874 items were lent to others (filled requests)

**In-house photocopying/campus document delivery:** 1,064 items delivered to Medical Center clients

**User education:** 2,765 clients attended 209 orientations and instructional teaching sessions

**Triangle Research Libraries Network (TRLN):** A partnership of Duke, NC Central, NC State, and UNC-Chapel Hill for cooperative collection development, resource sharing, and technical innovation.
