These figures are based on fiscal year: July, 2004 to June, 2005.

Founded: 1930; Seeley G. Mudd Building completed in 1975

Total operating budget 2004/05: 3.68 million (This includes Archives)

Staff: 39.25 FTE including 15 professional librarians (This includes Archives)

Staffing: The Library is open 86 hours per week

Collection: 290,524 volumes including the Trent Collection in the History of Medicine; approximately 738 current print subscriptions and 3,000 electronic journal titles

Total items added to collection: 2,888

Total number of primary clients: 13,023

Lending of items (external circulation): 18,070

Gate count: 136,838

Net assignable square feet: 47,526

Information services: 13,065 questions were answered at the Library Service Desk and other service points

Interlibrary loan: 1,567 items were borrowed; 13,191 items were lent to others (filled requests)

In-house photocopying/campus document delivery: 1,266 items delivered to Medical Center clients

User education: 2,719 clients attended 252 orientations and instructional teaching sessions
