# Facts & Figures: 2005-2006

*These figures are based on fiscal year: July, 2005 to June, 2006.*

**Founded:** 1930; Seeley G. Mudd Building completed in 1975

**Total operating budget 2004/05:** 3.695 million (This includes Archives)

**Staff:** 39.25 FTE including 15 professional librarians (This includes Archives)

**Staffing:** The Library is open 86 hours per week

**Collection:** 292,972 volumes including the Trent Collection in the History of Medicine; approximately 624 current print subscriptions and 3,556 electronic journal titles

**Total items added to collection:** 3,281

**Total number of primary clients:** 13,023

**Lending of items (external circulation):** 22,227

**Gate count:** 143,996

**Net assignable square feet:** 47,526

**Information services:** 10,357 questions were answered at the Library Service Desk and other service points

**Interlibrary loan:** 1,450 items were borrowed; 13,200 items were lent to others (filled requests)

**In-house photocopying/campus document delivery:** 1,286 items delivered to Medical Center clients

**User education:** 3,229 clients attended 392 orientations and instructional teaching sessions

**Triangle Research Libraries Network (TRLN):** A partnership of Duke, NC Central, NC State, and UNC-Chapel Hill for cooperative collection development, resource sharing, and technical innovation.
