

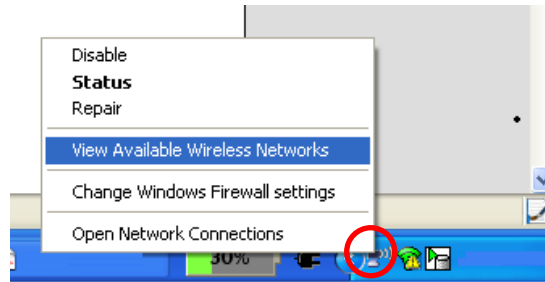

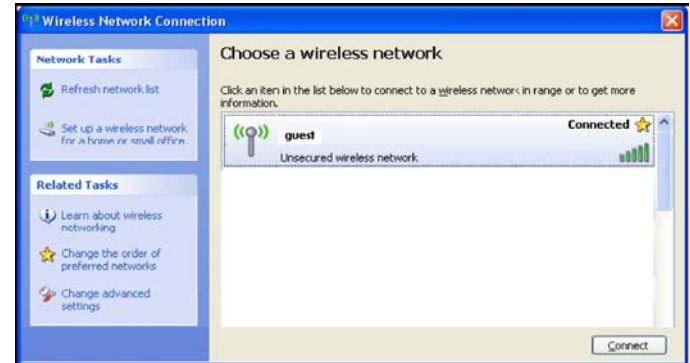
## How Do I Connect as a Guest?

Duke University Health System (DUHS) is pleased to provide free wireless Internet access for guests using computers and devices capable of receiving and transmitting 802.11 b/g wireless signals.

1. Right click on the wireless network icon in the taskbar and then select **View Available Wireless Networks**



2. Select the **guest** SSID in the available Wireless Network list and then click **Connect**.



3. Open a Web browser and browse to <http://www.dukehealth.org>. If you are already connected, your browser should display the requested Webpage. If the preceding Webpage is not displayed, then your browser will be redirected to the DUHS Wireless Guest access page.
4. You will be prompted to accept a certificate. This message will appear differently depending on the Web browser being used.
5. If prompted, **Click continue to Website**. Read the guidelines on the DUHS Wireless Guest access page seen below, and then click the **Connect** button to access the Internet.

Duke University Health System (DUHS) is pleased to provide free wireless internet access for portable computers and devices capable of receiving specific wireless signals. Please note the following guidelines:

- As with most public wireless hot spots, the DUHS guest wireless network is **not secure**. Therefore, it is possible other wireless users can intercept information being sent and received from your device. Consequently, you should be cautious and not transmit credit card information, passwords or any other sensitive personal information while using the wireless hot spot.
- DUHS will not be responsible for any personal information in a credit card that is compromised.
- DUHS will not be responsible for any damage caused to your hardware or software due to electric surge, security issues or consequences caused by misuse or hacking.
- Your wireless network traffic will be captured as a part of the DUHS central network management processes.
- You may use the DUHS wireless network in a responsible manner, and in compliance with federal, state and local laws, including, but not limited to, not transmitting or receiving illegal or harmful material, copyright theft, or downloading copyrighted material. Violators are subject to losing their wireless access at DUHS provided.
- Retention and/or monitoring of a user's access to the DUHS wireless network are the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian.
