AGREEMENT FOR COMMERCIAL USE OF REPRODUCTIONS OF MATERIALS FROM THE HISTORY OF MEDICINE COLLECTIONS

The History of Medicine Collections, as part of its service to scholarship and in the interest of the widest possible dissemination of information, will make certain of its resources available for commercial publication or broadcast. The Library reserves the right to refuse requests, and may negotiate a separate and unique contract including royalty agreements, especially for large projects or for valuable or unique resources.

PERMISSION

The Publisher or Broadcast Producer is responsible for compliance with all copyright and other legal requirements applicable to reproduction involving rights, permissions, and copyright, and agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Duke University, its officers and employees, and any and all of them, against and from any liability, loss, cost or expense whatsoever, including attorney's fees, which Duke University, its officers and employees, any or all of them, may have incurred at any time arising out of or relating to the reproduction of its library materials under this agreement. The Publisher or Producer also agrees that any copyrights placed on the finished publication or broadcast shall in no way restrict the rights of Duke University in further use of the original materials, including the right to allow other reproduction in commercial publications or productions.

The permission herein granted is applicable in so far and only in so far as the rights of the History of Medicine Collections are concerned. The Library claims only physical ownership of most History of Medicine material. The Publisher or Producer also agrees to pay the University's standard fees for all photographic and other reproductions made at the Publisher's or Producer's request.
