Selected Databases

(<http://www.mclibrary.duke.edu/databases>) — Many of these are full-text databases or have links to full-text articles

- *CINAHL* — nursing and allied health
- *Clinical Pharmacology* — drug information, interaction tool, and patient handouts
- *EBM Reviews* — evidence-based medicine resources, including the *Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews*
- *MD Consult* — online textbooks, practice guidelines, and patients handouts
- *MEDLINE* (available via PubMed and Ovid) — medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, pre-clinical sciences, and the health care system
- *UpToDate* — concise clinical topic reviews
- *Web of Science* — multidisciplinary coverage; cited reference searching
